ANNIE MEDICO CAMP DIRECTOR

Head Coach Annie Medico is in her second year at the helm of the Drury Panthers softball program. In her first season, the Panthers compiled a 20-37 overall mark and continued to progress as the season went on. They won 6 of their last 11 games, including a shut-out of nationally ranked No. 7 Lewis. Drury finished in the top 3 in the GLVC Conference in many offensive categories and garnered two all-conference selections and an all-region selection in only their first season.

Annie is a native of Tulsa, OK and former standout at Missouri State University. As a player, Medico was a 4 year starter and two-time All-Missouri Valley Conference short-stop for the Bears. She appeared in 201 games during her career, recording 125 hits and driving in 56 runs.

Prior to coming to Drury, Medico was an assistant at Southern Indiana. Medico helped lead the Screaming Eagles to a 95-62 mark in three seasons. Southern Indiana had a record breaking season last year finishing 39-18, including 17-5 in the GLVC and finished third in the NCAA-II Great Lakes regional, as well as No. 22 in the final national poll.

Coach Medico also served a year as a volunteer assistant at Missouri State University assisting with all aspects of the Bears program prior to accepting the position at USI.
