## High School Individual Elite Camp

June 8 - 10

Registration beginning at 2 p.m. in Weiser Gym/First session begins at 3 p.m.

Camp runs daily from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. with camp ending at 4 p.m. on June 26

Cost: Residential - \$225 Commuter - \$175

This camp is for athletes entering the 9th - 12th grade. Each camper will receive a Drury University Lady Panther basketball and a camp t-shirt. Emphasis will be placed on advanced fundamentals, shooting technique/footwork, individual offense and individual defense. Each day will be filled with individual instruction and team competition. Special awards will be given daily and at the conclusion of camp.

This camp is for the serious basketball player who has the true desire to improve her skills.

\*Residential campers for Individual camp will be housed in Wallace and Smith halls with 24 hour supervision and all campers will dine in Findlay Student Center. Campers should bring broken in basketball shoes, plenty of socks, all linens and towels and other personal toiletries and items.



## Future Stars Fundamental Day Camp

Session I June 11-13

Registration beginning at 8 a.m. in Weiser Gym on the first day of each session

9 a.m. - Noon and 1 p.m. - 5 p.m. daily

Cost: \$135

This camp is designed for players entering 3rd - 8th grade and has become a hallmark of the program. Each camper will receive a Drury University Lady Panther basketball and a camp t-shirt. Each day is filled with instruction based on the very basics of fundamentals with emphasis on becoming a better overall player. Special attention will be given to shooting and footwork, specific offensive fundamentals as well as the development of self-confidence, teamwork and motivation. Special awards will be given daily and at the conclusion of the camp. Fee does not include lunch. Each camper is encouraged to bring their own lunch as a space and supervision during the lunch hour will be provided. A camper may go off campus with parental approval. Campers will be allowed to swim in the National Championship pool during camp with parental approval. This camp is a great stepping stone for young players eager to become better players. The camp is geared for a high energy setting, where the kids stay active and enthused while learning fundamentals.
